NEEF MC Mandate

- The NEEF MC mandate as given by the parties to the BC/Alcan 1997 Agreement is to:
 - Conduct a process to reconsider previous decisions and to prepare a report that will:
 - ...review, assess and report on options that may be available for the downstream enhancement of the Nechako watershed area.
 - ...consider how NEEF MC decisions should be implemented.

Operating Principles

- NEEF MC has adopted the following principles:
 - Openness and Transparency
 - Inclusiveness
 - Decision-Making
 - Geographic Scope
 - Timeliness
 - Cost-Effectiveness
 - Financial Accountability

Consultation process - Phases

Our approach is to conduct the consultation process in four phases;

1. Information:

share background information regarding the 1997 Agreement and the 2001
NEEF MC report, and request input on the proposed process;

2. Consultation:

 learn the interests and ideas of individuals, stakeholders, industry, First Nations, and government regarding uses of the fund for downstream environmental enhancement;

3. Confirmation:

 share what we have learned and provide an opportunity to affirm the information that was provided to us during the consultation process; and

4. Reporting:

deliver our decisions on the use of the NEEF.
